



Diego Merino. Bio.

Born in Mexico City in 1977, since the early eighties Diego Merino has been closely following motorsport. His early memories date back when F1 raced in Mexico City and Montréal where he assisted his photographer father shooting pictures around the Paddock.

Having his cut teeth as the FIA as Technical Assistant and after being involved in the organization of over 50 Grands Prix around the world, he has become a well known face in the F1 Paddock. Since 2011, Diego began working with F1 journalist Peter Windsor both in production and editorial. His involvement as assistant also included covering F1 Test Days in Jerez and Barcelona.

In 2013, Diego became TRE (The Racer's Edge) correspondent on www.youtube.com/peterwindsor, covering news such as Sergio Perez presentation at McLaren and first test of Carlos Sainz Jr for Toro Rosso Formula 1 team. Besides being correspondent, other duties and functions included photography, camera and editing. Additional events covered include the Gilles Villeneuve remembrance in Maranello and Trofeo Bandini in Brisighella, Italy.

Other publications to which Diego has regularly contributed are Marca.com and AutoyPista published weekly. Since 2012, he also became Freelance Photographer, Writer & F1 Social Media Coordinator on www.iberianMPH.com In addition to this work, Diego is an F1 Analyst on Vuelta Rapida GT and regular guest on CopeGP, both on Spanish radio.
